# The Frank L. Weil Awards

JCC Association established the Frank L. Weil Awards in 1950 in the name of our leader who served with brilliant distinction as president of JWB from 1940 to 1950. These biennial awards recognize distinguished contributions to the three areas of JCC Association's work: the Jewish Community Center field, the Armed Services field, and the advancement of North American Jewish education and culture.

## AWARD PROCEDURE:

We seek recommendations for awards for outstanding contributions from the three fields of the Association's service on the local, regional and continental levels. Criteria for the selection of nominees for the awards are presented below. A jury in each of the three fields considers all recommendations. A JCC Association continental leader heads each jury.

## CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

### Distinguished Contribution to the Jewish Community Center Field

1. The person's record of outstanding service in the Jewish Community Center field
2. The quality and character of the person's leadership in the Jewish Community Center field

### Distinguished Contribution to the Armed Services Field

1. The person's record of outstanding service in promoting the welfare of Jewish men and women in the Armed Forces and Veterans Hospitals of the United States
2. The quality and character of the person's leadership in the Armed Services field
